Competition categories

A-category: World Championships/World Wide Competitions, World Cup –competitions, IFAGG Championships and TC approved competitions

B-category: Other international competitions

C-category: National Competitions f.ex. National Championships

Age categories

Children Category girls age 10 – 12 and age 12 – 14 (gymnasts during competition year 10, 11 and 12 or 12, 13 and 14 years old)

Junior Category girls age 14 – 16 (gymnasts during competition year 14, 15 and 16 years old)
means during year 2005 girls born -89, -90 and -91

Exception alternatives for age limits: Two (2) members of the group may be one (1) year younger than the given minimum age OR one (1) gymnast may be one (1) year older than the official maximum age and one (1) gymnast one (1) year younger. Reserve gymnast belongs to the group.

Senior Category women over 16 means during year 2005 women born -88 or earlier

Two members of the group may be one year younger than the given minimum age. Reserve gymnast belongs to the group.

Gymnasts must prove their identity and age with passport to IFAGG officials in every international competition.

According to AGG competition rules: **NEW!**

AGG rules: 1.3.1. A group consists of 6 – 10 gymnasts in seniors, 6 – 12 gymnasts in juniors, and 6 – 14 gymnasts in children category. A group can be nominated (for ex. club name, group name).

1.3.2. A group is allowed to have one nominated reserve gymnast. Reserve gymnast is a member of the group.

Applying World Cup competitions

TC decision 17.6.05: The deadline for applying World Cup competitions is in the end of March 2006 when concerning 2007 competitions. In the end of March 2007 will be the deadline for applying World Cup competitions for 2008. Then the TC meeting in the beginning of April could make the exact competition calendar. For other competitions (TC-approved) it is enough to apply 6 months before the competition.

Judges course (all levels) will be arranged in January 2006 in Spain, near Barcelona. The exact date and other information will be announced latest in the end of October.
