Countries Ranking

In World Championships in protocol results will be announce countries ranking. The country ranking will be count from 1, 2 or 3 teams, but maximum 3 teams per country.

For countries ranking will be count the highest Total score (TV+AV+EXE) of each team from Preliminaries or Finals. If the team(s) no entry in Finals the Total score for country ranking will be count from Preliminaries.

Example:

Team 1 (17.80 score from Preliminaries / **17.95** score from Finals)

Team 2 (**17.30** score from Preliminaries / 17.20 score from Finals)

Team 3 (**16.80** score from Preliminaries)

Score for countries ranking: **52.05 points**

The countries ranking come into force in World Championships 2009 in Moscow.

Announcement

The mandate periods of IFAGG's three board members end in GA in June. The three Board members and President will be elected in 2009 General Assembly in Moscow. The members of board are hoped to be ready to commit to the developing work of IFAGG.

Applications and CV:s should be sent **by 30th April 2009** to the address of IFAGG office and addressed to the board. Note: every member that proposes a member is responsible for hers/his costs (minimum 2 – 3 meetings/year).

Competing group + Age categories, 2009

Women (seniors)

Women over 16 years old

- Gymnasts born -93 or earlier
- 2 members of the nominated group, that are competing on the carpet may be one (1) year younger than the given minimum age
- Group consists of 6 – 12 nominated gymnasts (possible reserve gymnasts belong to the group – maximum 12 gymnasts); there can be more than two (2) gymnasts one (1) year younger in the group of 12 gymnasts
- If you nominate 12 gymnasts for the first competition – they have to remain same during World Cup 2009; if you nominate less than 12 gymnasts for the first competition you may complete your group till 12 gymnasts
- nomination for each competition (also preliminaries and finals) must be done among nominated group

Juniors

Girls age 14 – 16 years old (gymnasts during competition year 14, 15 and 16 years old)

- Gymnasts born -95, -94 and -93
- Exception alternatives in competing group, that are competing on the carpet may be
 - two (2) members of group may be one (1) year younger than the minimum given age OR
 - one (1) gymnast may be one (1) year older than the official maximum age and one (1) gymnast one (1) year younger than the minimum age
- Group consists of 6 – 12 nominated gymnasts (possible reserve gymnasts belong to the group – maximum 12 gymnasts), there can be more exceptions in ages in the group of 12
- If you nominate 12 gymnasts for the first competition – they have to remain same during World Challenge Cup 2009; if you nominate less than 12 gymnasts for the first competition you may complete your group till 12 gymnasts
- nomination to each competition (also preliminaries and finals) must be done among nominated group

Girls 12 - 14

Girls age 12 – 14 years old (gymnasts during competition year 12, 13 and 14 years old)

- Gymnasts born -97, - 96 and -95
- Exception alternatives;
 - two (2) members of group may be one (1) year younger than the minimum given age OR
 - one (1) gymnast may be one (1) year older than the official maximum age and one (1) gymnast one (1) year younger than the minimum age
- Group consists of 6 – 14 gymnasts and reserve gymnast belongs to the group

Girls 10 - 12

Girls age 10 – 12 years old (gymnasts during competition year 10, 11 and 12 years old)

- Gymnasts born -99, - 98 and -97
- Exception alternatives;
 - two (2) members of group may be one (1) year younger than the minimum given age OR
 - one (1) gymnast may be one (1) year older than the official maximum age and one (1) gymnast one (1) year younger than the minimum age
- Group consists of 6 – 14 gymnasts and reserve gymnast belongs to the group

* Please note that the age categories replace from Competition Rules, updated 17062005 these two points:

New licences for competitors and judges come into force 15st March 2009

All A-members (National AGG Federation /Association) or B-members (club) it is responsible to prepare all necessary documentation and send to IFAGG.

Judges applications

Judge list for World Championships

The IFAGG Board decide invite the Judges for World Championships.

The Technical Committee (TC) prepares Judges List and make presentation to the Board.

After the Board confirmation TC annunciate Judge List for the World Championships and send this information to the national Federation / Association.

In World Championships in Judge Panel can be Judges only with 1 and 2 International level.

Judge list for World Cups competition

For World Cup competitions the national AGG Federation / Association send the Judge(s) Inscription form to IFAGG office. The Technical Committee (TC) prepares Judges List and make presentation to the Board. After the Board confirmation TC annunciate Judge List for the World Cups competitions and send this information to the national Federation / Association. In World Cups competitions in the Judge panel can be maximum 4 new Judges (International level 3), included reserves Judges.

Important:

Please, send to IFAGG office the Judge(s) Inscription form as soon as possible before the competition, because the Judge can be ready for travel to the competition.

Anti-Doping

Those gymnasts that have any kind of illness in which they need medication for, have to contact their doctor and ask and fill up the form of WADA together with the doctor. And then send that form to the national AGG federation and to IFAGG.
