IFAGG Training Camp 2011

The Bulgarian Federation of Aesthetic Group Gymnastics and IFAGG have pleasure to invite you to participate in an international training camp in Varna, Bulgaria 05.-10.07.2011. Arrival on 5th July and departure on 10th.



The fee for participation in the camp (gymnasts and coaches) is 400 Euro per person, which includes 5 nights in the hotel (3 or 4 persons in the room), 5 days full board (all inclusive), local transport, training hall, lecturers. The accommodation and the training hall will be the same where the World Championships 2010 took place.

AGG Competition Rules

Technical committee has been updating Competition Rules and the new updated rules will be delivered to members as soon as possible.

Judges registrations to competitions

Proposal of judges to each A-category competition must be done by IFAGG judges registration form by the date informed in the competition invitation or latest by the definitive entry date. The registration form is attached.

Licenses 2011

All gymnasts and judges who are taking part to IFAGG international events during 2011 need to have a license for the year 2011. The prices of each license type are the same as in 2010.

Senior gymnast - 20 EUR/ year 2011

Junior gymnast -10 EUR/ year 2011

Judge - 50 EUR/ year 2011

License payments

The gymnast(s) / judge(s) Licenses is paid only one (1) time during the year. The Licenses have to be paid to IFAGG from national AGG Federation /Association or directly from club before that gymnast(s)/ judge(s) participate in the 1st International competition (A-category competitions) during the year.

World Cup and Challenge Cup points 2011

The points will be counted the same way as previous years.

World Challenge Cup

For the final ranking (World Challenge Cup results) will be counted total WCC points from the three (3) part-competitions. The World Challenge Cup rankings will be counted with following system: Ten (10) best teams of every WCC part-competition will get points as follows:

- rank first (1.) of competition gets 12 WCC points
- rank second (2.) of competition gets 10 WCC points
- rank third (3.) of competition gets 8 WCC points
- rank fourth (4.) of competition gets 7 WCC points
- rank fifth (5.) of competition gets 6 WCC points
- 6. – 5 points etc.
- 7. - 4
- 8. - 3
- 9. - 2
- 10. – 1

World Cup

- 4 competitions/year
- The group can participate in 1-4 competitions on their own choice

For the final ranking (World Cup results) will be counted for every team points from their three (3) best part-competitions. In final World Cup competition / World Cup IV in Russia points will be given as * 1,5 – normal world cup points. The World Cup rankings will be counted in a following system: Ten (10) best teams of every WC part-competition will get points as follows:

- rank first (1.) of competition gets 12 WC points
 - rank second (2.) of competition gets 10 WC points
 - rank third (3.) of competition gets 8 WC points
 - rank fourth (4.) of competition gets 7 WC points
 - rank fifth (5.) of competition gets 6 WC points
 - 6. – 5 points etc.
 - 7. - 4
 - 8. - 3
 - 9. - 2
 - 10. – 1
- Final World Cup IV 2011 points will be given one and half times / normally. Rank first (1.) of final competition will get 18 points, rank second (2.) will get 15 points, rank

third (3.) will get 12 points, rank fourth (4.) will get 10,5 points, rank fifth (5.) will get 9 points, rank sixth (6.) will get 7,5 points, rank seventh (7.) 6 points, rank eight (8.) 4,5 points, rank ninth (9.) 3 points and rank tenth (10.) 1,5 points
