



Job Description: Disciplinary Committee Member

Summary: The Disciplinary Committee at IFAGG plays a pivotal role in upholding the integrity of aesthetic group gymnastics and ensuring compliance with IFAGG Statutes and regulations. Together with the Chairperson of DC, a team of DC committee members investigates reported breaches and makes decisions on sanctions when necessary.

Duties and Responsibilities of DC:

1. **Main duties and responsibilities:** DC is authorized to investigate and sanction any breach of IFAGG Statutes and IFAGG Regulations by the lead of DC Chairperson.

Competences and Qualifications:

1. **Legal Background:** Preferably possess a legal background with experience in sports and/or association law.
2. **Independence:** Maintain independence from IFAGG member federations and clubs, ensuring no conflicts of interest. Maintain neutrality and equality in work and in decision making towards all IFAGG members. A DC member can't be a president of IFAGG member organization. If DC member is a judge, must this person leave judging in IFAGG sanctioned competitions during the time in DC.
3. **Ethical Standards:** Uphold and promote the highest ethical standards and professionalism. Experience in ethical work is advantageous.
4. **Communication:** Excellent communication and interpersonal skills are preferred. The working language of IFAGG is English.
5. **International Sports Knowledge:** Understanding international sports governance and the specific challenges and nuances of aesthetic group gymnastics is advantageous.
6. **Geographical Diversity:** Represent a different country from other DC members (maximum one member per country).
