Refer to Payment/Bank Account information, on the last page of Directive.</p> <p>An invoice will be sent after the registration deadline.  <b><u>Please remit the payment in Canadian dollars (C\$).</u></b>  The <b><u>participating delegation</u></b> is responsible for <b><u>any and all bank fees</u></b> associated with the bank transfers.</p> <p><b>Late payments:</b>  According to IFAGG rules, late registrations and payments are subject to a late fee charge of CAD \$160 per group (paid to the LOC).</p> <p>The entry fees are <b><u>NON-REFUNDABLE.</u></b></p>
<b>FOREIGN ATHLETES</b>	<p>All individuals (athletes, coaches and judges) taking part in a Gymnastics Ontario Federation sanctioned competitions must be a registered participant of Gymnastics Ontario. This includes all individuals who do not reside in Canada.</p> <p>The cost for non-Canadian participants is \$56.50 CDN. Foreign membership entitles the applicant to insurance coverage only. No other member benefits are applicable. <b>Foreign Membership fees are non-refundable.</b> Payment deadline by Definitive registration.</p>

<b>INSURANCE</b>	<p>The Canadian Aesthetic Group Gymnastics, CAGG and the IFAGG will not be held responsible for any liabilities in case of accidents, illness, repatriation and the like.</p> <p>The IFAGG Technical Regulations foresee that all participating delegations are responsible for making their own arrangements to have the necessary valid insurance coverage against illness, accidents and for repatriation for all the members of their Delegation.</p> <p>The LOC will verify the insurance upon arrival of the delegation members (e.g. cover note or photocopy of the valid policy).</p>
<b>MEDICAL SERVICES</b>	<p>The Local Organizing Committee will provide a medical first-aid service, a doctor and emergency medical transportation in the competition area.</p>
<b>ANTIDOPING</b>	<p>IFAGG Code of Discipline</p> <p>It's a condition of participation in IFAGG's activities that gymnasts and their assistants and representatives will follow the national and international doping rules. All gymnasts and their assistants and representatives are obligated to know the doping rules. <b>PERSONAL DATA PROTECTION</b>	<p>Personal information of registered gymnasts, coaches, judges and volunteers are used in published official competition protocols, rgform.eu online environment, competition's/federation's website and in social media channels. By registering, the gymnasts, coaches, judges and volunteers give consent to publish visual materials (photos, videos). In case the person is not consent with the previous, LOC and Federation has to be informed in written form by the start of the competition.</p>
<b>MEDIA</b>	<p>Only photographers and journalists with accreditation are allowed to take pictures and film the event. (registering via rgform.eu or onsite).</p>

<b>ACCREDITATION</b>	<p>The Delegation will be accredited upon their arrival</p> <p>During the accreditation Heads of Delegations are required to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Confirm the correct names spelling of their entire delegation,</li> <li>• Manage passport control of all gymnasts,</li> <li>• Provide proof of medical insurance of all delegation members,</li> <li>• Manage music check control,</li> <li>• Submit personal data protection declaration,</li> <li>• Make any necessary payments.</li> </ul>
<b>VISA INVITATION</b>	<p>All delegations requiring Visas must complete the visa request form (found in KSIS event) and send it to LOC.</p> <p>The request must include the function, full name, gender, date of birth, citizenship and passport number, passport expiry date, the arrival and departure dates of the delegation member, as well as the city the visa application support letter must be sent to.</p> <p>Visit: <a href="https://ircc.canada.ca/english/visit/visas.asp">https://ircc.canada.ca/english/visit/visas.asp</a> for more information.</p>
